Scholarship Opening Soon



As many of you may know, we are preparing to launch our scholarship applications for the 2022 school year. Applications open in January 2022. Successful applicants will have demonstrated their contribution to society by having exhibited good citizenship through extensive volunteerism, community service or character-building initiatives and by participating in humanitarian causes (minimum 150 hours). The minimum amount of the scholarship is \$1,000. We strongly encourage students to apply for our scholarship and look forward to reading your applications!

ELIGIBILITY

- Hold Canadian citizenship, permanent resident status, landed immigrant or refugee status
- Be in the graduating year of uninterrupted full-time studies in high school or CEGEP
- Exceptions may be considered for those who have undertaken a gap year for academic pursuits or community service-based activities
- Be between the ages of 16 to 24
- Financial need is taken into consideration
